

University of Wales Gregynog –Colloquia Support Fund 2008/2009

In July 2008, the Council of the University of Wales resolved to allocate £20,000 to the Gregynog Colloquia Support Fund for the financial year 2008/09.

The Gregynog Colloquia Support Fund currently exists to support research activity, particularly collaborative research activity between the University's accredited institutions. Applications which encourage post-graduate involvement are especially welcomed.

Within the context of the general purpose of the Fund, applications for support must meet one or more of the following criteria:-

- the colloquium facilitates and assists post graduate research
- the colloquium enhances the University research profile
- the colloquium fosters inter-institutional collaboration in research

The Fund provides a significant subsidy towards accommodation and food costs. In 2007/08, £20,000 was allocated between 30 departments within higher education institutions in Wales who made use of the conference facilities at Gregynog.

The amount of the award is related to actual bed night usage and is calculated at a reduction of £10 per bed night. Due to the nature of the research fund the colloquia award will only apply to staff and post-graduate students from accredited institutions of the University of Wales.

Please note that you are required to have made a provisional booking for your colloquium before submitting your application for support from the Gregynog Colloquia Support Fund.
