

Online Library - Tourism Resources

All students studying for a University of Wales qualification at a collaborative centre can take advantage of the Online Library. This web-based library service provides students with supplementary resources to those offered by the library service at a collaborative centre. It is continually being developed, with more subject areas and new resources being added and as part of our Global Campus website, the Online Library can be accessed 24 hours a day, from anywhere in the world.

Business Source Complete

Large scholarly business database, subjects covered include marketing, management, accounting, finance, banking, economics, management information systems, and production operations management. It offers students full text access to over **3,500 journals and general business magazines**. Students can change the language of the user interface for this database.

Datamonitor 360

Datamonitor 360 is a comprehensive business information database containing company, country and industry reports. The database includes: SWOT analyses; company financials; PESTLE analyses; emerging markets information; industry profiles; news and opinion; and more.

Psychology And Behavioral Sciences Collection

This database offers nearly **400 full text journals** on emotional and behavioural characteristics, psychiatry and psychology, mental processes, anthropology, and observational & experimental methods. Students can change the language of the user interface for this database.

eJournals

The Library has an **A to Z List of eJournals** which students can search to find a journal in our collection. It includes all journals that we subscribe to, for example **Annals of Tourism Research** and **Tourism Management**, plus many open access journals.

eBooks

Our ebooks collection offers additional books to the core books recommended by a collaborative centre. It currently contains **over 700 ebooks** for all our subjects, and over 3,000 out of copyright ebooks.

Study Skills

There is a dedicated section to show students **how to reference, avoid plagiarism, find theses and dissertations**, and it offers a list of available **study skills ebooks** from our ebook collection.
