

The Gareth Jones Memorial Travelling Scholarship

This Scholarship is provided from the income of a Memorial Fund raised by public subscription to perpetuate the memory of Gareth Richard Vaughan Jones, a graduate of the University, who met his death at the hand of bandits in Inner Mongolia, 12 August, 1935.

1. The Gareth Jones Memorial Scholarship will be awarded annually by the University to a graduate of the University of Wales on the recommendation of the Academic Board provided a suitable candidate is forthcoming.
2. The Scholarship will be of the value of approximately £3,000 payable in two instalments. The period of the tenure of the Scholarship shall be decided by the Academic Board.
3. The object of the Scholarship is to enable the holder to travel in foreign countries with a view to facilitating his/her study of international relations. No obligation to pursue a specific scheme of study shall be attached to the award of the Scholarship.
4. Preference will be given to a graduate of the University who signifies his/her intention to pursue or continue a scheme of study in preparation for work in journalism bearing on international affairs or for entry into State or other services relating to international affairs.
5. The holder of the Scholarship shall, at the conclusion of his/her tenure, submit a report of the work to the University through the Director, Academic Registry of the University.
6. Applications for the award of the Scholarship must reach the Director of Academic Affairs (ref: JP), University Registry, Cathays Park, Cardiff CF10 3NS, on or before 1 June.

Ysgoloriaeth Deithio Goffa Gareth Jones

Darperir yr Ysgoloriaeth hon o'r incwm o Gronfa Goffa a godwyd drwy danysgrifiadau cyhoeddus i beri cofio enw Gareth Richard Vaughan Jones, un o raddedigion y Brifysgol, a fu farw dan law lladron ym Mongolia Fewnol, 12 Awst, 1935.

1. Dyfernir Ysgoloriaeth Goffa Gareth Jones bob blwyddyn gan y Brifysgol i un o raddedigion Prifysgol Cymru ar argymhelliad y Bwrdd Academaidd, ar yr amod bod ymgeisydd addas ar gael.
2. Bydd yr Ysgoloriaeth yn werth rhyw £2,000 a delir mewn dau randaliad. Y Bwrdd Academaidd fydd yn penderfynu cyfnod deiliadaeth yr Ysgoloriaeth.
3. Amcan yr Ysgoloriaeth yw galluogi'r deiliad i deithio mewn gwledydd tramor gyda golwg ar hwyluso astudiaethau ar gysylltiadau cydwladol. Ni fydd rhwymedigaeth i ddilyn cynllun astudio penodol ynghlwm wrth ddyfarniad yr Ysgoloriaeth.
4. Rhoddir blaenoriaeth i un o raddedigion y Brifysgol sy'n mynegi bwriad i ddilyn neu i barhau cynllun astudio i baratoi ar gyfer gwaith mewn newyddiaduraeth ynghylch materion cydwladol neu i baratoi ar gyfer mynd i wasanaeth y Wladwriaeth neu wasanaethau eraill sy'n ymwneud â materion cydwladol.
5. Rhaid i ddeiliad yr Ysgoloriaeth, pan ddaw deiliadaeth yr ysgoloriaeth i ben, gyflwyno adroddiad ar y gwaith i'r Brifysgol drwy law Ysgrifennydd Cyffredinol y Brifysgol.
6. Rhaid i geisiadau am yr Ysgoloriaeth gyrraedd Ysgrifennydd Cyffredinol y Brifysgol (ref: EB), Cofrestrfa'r Brifysgol, Parc Cathays, Caerdydd CF10 3NS, ar neu cyn 1 Mehefin.
